

# On-site Safety & PERSONAL PROTECTION EQUIPMENT



Contained in this leaflet is all the information you will need prior to your visit to the Millbrook Proving Ground, regarding permits, security, onsite vehicles, and Personal Protection Equipment.

## Site Entry & SECURITY

Upon arrival, you will need to sign in at security to gain access to the site, or if issued with a COTAG pass, scan in and out every day at the turnstiles.

For confidentiality reasons, you must sign to agree not to divulge any information to outside parties about Millbrook's operations.

Photography is strictly forbidden without express permission from Millbrook Proving Ground – if you do require photography, please contact your host prior to your visit and a photography monitor can be arranged.

Millbrook reserve the right to search visitors (clothing, belongings, and vehicles) when entering and leaving the site.

## Driving ON-SITE

Vehicular admittance to the Proving Ground is by authorised pass only. If you require your own vehicle on-site, please visit the Security Lodge upon arrival.

## Working Safely ON-SITE

All visitors working on-site must do so in a safe manner and in accordance with Millbrook's safety procedures, Health, Safety and Environmental guidelines and relevant legislation.

Personal Protection Equipment is required in certain circumstances – please see overleaf to check which if any applies to you.

## Permits TO WORK

Permits to work or Certificates of Authorisation are required in the following circumstances:-

- Hot work (welding, cutting, grinding etc)
- Working on electrical systems
- Working on or near high voltage equipment (>450V)

Permits to work and Certificates of Authorisation can be obtained through your host.

## Control of Substances HAZARDOUS TO HEALTH (COSHH)

Any operation performed that falls under the COSHH Regulations requires a suitable and sufficient COSHH assessment. Material Safety Datasheets (MSDS) are required prior to allowing any chemicals on-site.

## Personal Protection EQUIPMENT (PPE)

You will be required to wear PPE whilst working in certain areas of the Proving Ground. Regular visitors are expected to bring their own, though occasional visitors can be loaned equipment, with the exception of footwear. If working in the following areas, please read the below requirements prior to your visit: -

### Working or Observing Visitors

During your visit, if you plan on working on or closely observing a vehicle or engine, the following PPE will be essential: -

- Safety Footwear
- Gloves
- Overalls
- Ear Protection
- A Bump Cap (optional)

### Powertrain Visitors

If working in the VTEC, a medical may be required. Please contact your host for details.
